**Phase 1 Phonics**

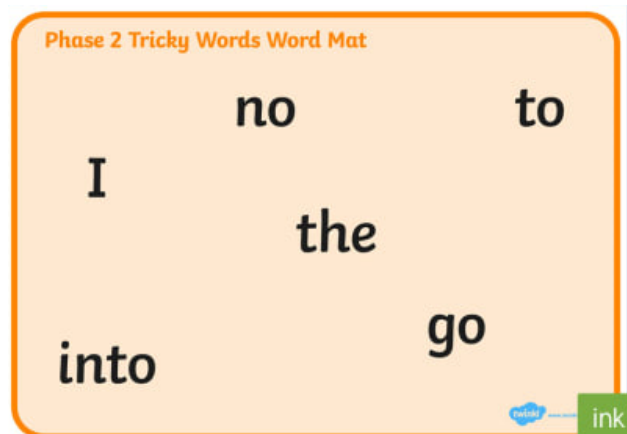
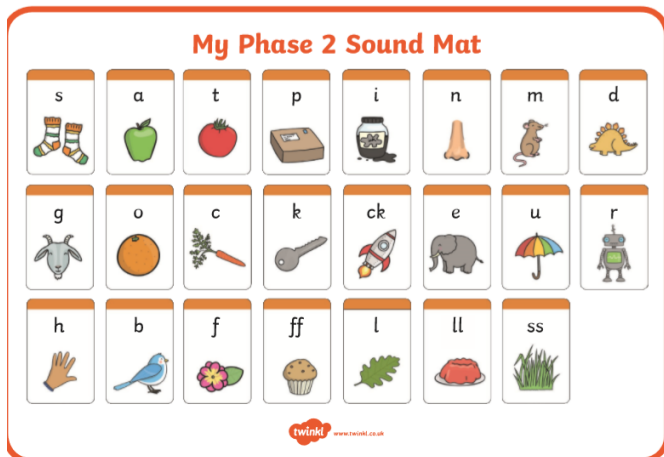
This phase supports the development of pre reading and writing skills. Children learn to listen attentively and talk about what they hear, say and do.

Activities to do at home:

- I spy- using initial sounds or colours
- Pairs- using rhyming words, initial sounds or pictures
- Singing nursery rhymes
- Add sound effects to stories when you read to your child before bed each night
- Movement and Music- guess the instrument, rhythm

**Phase 2 Phonics- Covered in Autumn 1**

Children will learn the 19 letters and be able to read and write some VC words *e.g. it, is, in* and CVC words *e.g. bus, pat, fill*.



Activities to do at home:

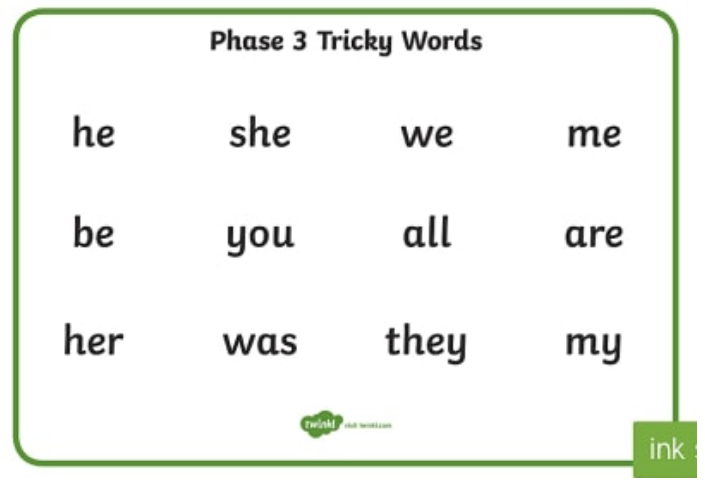
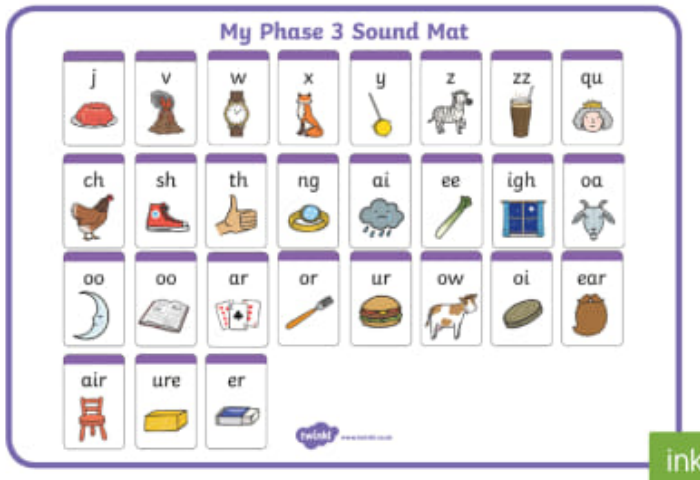
- Robot game- robot talk b-u-s (child says bus)
- I spy using letter sounds *e.g. c for cat*
- Play how many sounds or which sounds did you hear?
- Robot talk *e.g. "Get your c-oa-t" "Put on your h-a-t"*
- Simon says- using robot talk

**Phase 3 Phonics- Covered in Autumn 2 and Spring Term**

### Phonics in F2 Support for Parents

Children will learn another 26 phonemes (sounds) and lots more tricky words. Children will also learn the letter names (ABC) and how to form these. To be secure in phase 3 children will be expected to write words and sentences phonetically sounding out each word.



Activities to do at home:

- Continue to practise phase 1 and 2 skills using the games and websites.
- Look out for words in books and environment using digraphs and trigraphs.

### Phase 4 Phonics- Covered in Summer Term

No new sounds are taught at this phase. This phase is to consolidate children's knowledge of using the phase 2 and 3 sounds and writing words with 4 and 5 sounds together e.g. lost, crisp. They will also learn new tricky words.
