

## Attendance

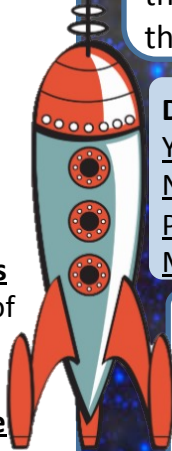
