Dear Parents/ Carers,

Three days to go and school re-opens again! A quick reminder of the plans for Monday. All procedures return to how they were in Autumn term.

### **Entrances and Exits**

F1, F2, Y1-Y4 children can be accompanied by **one parent** to their classroom door. Y5 and Y6 must enter school grounds **on their own**.

- EYFS via Castlefields
- KS1 via Kinglake Place
- Y3 and Y4 via the park entrance
- Y5 and Y6 via the tram entrance

Only families with siblings can walk through the school grounds to collect other children-please ensure social distancing throughout.

### **School Attendance:**

Attendance is mandatory and procedures return back to normal. All children are expected to attend school everyday from Monday 8<sup>th</sup> March. No work via Purple mash will be set unless a child is self isolating. If your child is sick, please ring the school office as normal. Holidays are not permitted in school time.

### **What to bring?**

Children will wear full school uniform and bring PE kits on Mondays for the week. Please can they bring their own labelled water bottle to school. Bookbags must come into school daily as we will read with your child as often as we can.

### **Bedtime routines:**

It is natural that children will have been going to bed later and rising later due to the change in circumstances. Please ensure children go to bed without screens nice and early on Sunday night to give them the very best start on Monday.

### **Lateral Flow Testing for households:**

Tests are available for you to complete at home if you wish to. See this link for further information. Please note-schools do NOT provide test kits for parents.
