## Learning at home

Reading at home is invaluable to your child's learning and progress. Please read with your child at home at least 4 times a week and sign their diaries. If your child reads at home and their diary is signed 4 times a week they will receive a treat on a Friday. Alongside their reading books, children are sent home with spelling and bear words every week. Spellings and bear words are tested every Friday.

Children in Year 2 will also receive homework every Friday.

#### P.E

P.E is every **Thursday**. Your child will need to have a full P.E kit that is appropriate for all weather types. All items of clothing (tshirt, shorts/jogging bottoms and trainers) must be **labelled** clearly. P.E kits may be taken home on a Friday to be washed and brought back to class.

As the weather gets cooler, please ensure you send your child appropriate clothing and footwear for all weather types.
