

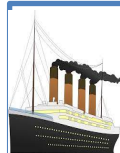
Our fantastic **TOPIC** this term is '*The Titanic*', a topic which the children have already quickly engaged with! Our other topic this term will be Forces in Science.

P.E

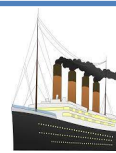
