## **Topics this term**

Our interesting History topic this term is 'Marvellous Monarchs'. We will be learning about the most famous Queens in England's History; Queen Elizabeth I, Queen Victoria and Queen Elizabeth II. In our history lessons we will be learning about life in the Tudor and Victorian times. In Art lessons with Ms Whitrow we will be developing our drawing and collage skills.
