Objectives of the visit including links to school development plan

- 1. Assess achievement of Welbeck pupil premium children cf non-PP Welbeck and national non-PP for AY22 at KS2;
- 2. Discuss effectiveness of measures put in place to reduce to reduce gap in AY22;
- 3. Discuss prospects for AY23 and provision for PP children.

Strengths identified

Welbeck PP are significantly above national related expectations and greater depth of national non-PP in reading, writing, maths, RWM. This is an outstanding achievement.

Areas for development and issues to follow up further

There are some gaps still to close between Welbeck non-PP and PP in writing, maths and RWM at KS2. These are relatively small and given the small size of cohort may represent only 1-2 pupils pa.

Action to be taken following report back to governing body, including timescales for reconsideration by governors if appropriate

Continue to monitor PP children and make targeted interventions to reduce gap in writing and maths. Assess the differential impact of 'cost of living' crisis on PP children and take appropriate mitigating action when possible.

Evaluation of visit (include impact on attainment, where is the evidence?)

The visit focused on analysing the data and seeking to explain the data. In particular, the focus was on how to identify which interventions have the most positive effect, how this can be measured and replicated across year groups.
