If your child has a **Full Time** Nursery place please send them with a named lunch box. All children must bring a named water bottle.

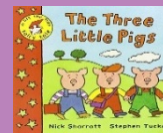
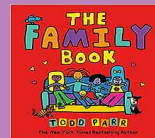
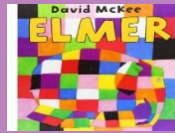
Please **NO** crisps, sweets, chocolate or fizzy drinks/juice.
