#### **Charity support:**

#### **Online safety:**

This continues to cause worry and concerns for Primary age children. Research shows that **50% of children aged 7-11 have witnessed sexual or violent content whilst watching You Tube or Tiktok.** This is hugely worrying and will have a negative impact on children in the future. Online safety should be top priority in all households. Please ensure all 13+ APPs are deleted from devices. Children using these APPs is a safeguarding risk. Please take time to look at devices and check they are safe for your child to use. All screens should be removed from bedrooms at night.

#### Attendance:

We are committed to ensuring our school overall attendance is above national average. Please remember all children are expected to attend school even if a family member is unwell or they have a mild cold/cough/headache. Children must also not miss school to travel abroad for extended periods to see sick family members. We have a very long waiting list so school places **may be removed** if children are taken abroad for a long period of time. **Safety:**
