Circle Time in KS1

- Looked at RSHE medium term planning to see how it is being used to inform lesson plans - LO are highlighted weekly to show coverage and inform short term planning
- Looked at MW's lesson plan for this week's circle time – 'I can explain what a stereotype is'.
- Observed an outstanding lesson delivered to Y2/1

Circle Time in EYFS

- Observed an excellent circle time in EYFS on 'what makes a good friend'.
- Lesson was well planned and well delivered capturing the children's interest.
- Looked at EYFS planning outline for RSHE.

Assembly

- Caught the end of KS1's weekly assembly led by M
- Assemblies are planned termly to cover further LOs from RSHE long term/medium term planning.

Areas for development and issues to follow up further:

- LG to ensure all RSHE learning objectives are covered by the end of this term.
- Meet with LG to discuss and update RE policy.
- LG to feed back to me about her RE course.
- Autumn Term 24 to look at RE scheme of work and its implementation across the school.
- Liaise with KW (RC) and LC on implementing a new programme to replace DARE.
