**Objectives of the visit including links to school development plan:**  
To discuss the development of PSHE in school.

**Clarification of related areas:**

RSHE – Relationships, Sex and Health Education.  
(This curriculum area is well established in school with its own Policy and Scheme of Work which includes the two statutory elements: Relationship Education and Health Education. Parents can withdraw pupils from Sex Education element.)

PSHE – Personal, Social, Health and Economic Education

SMSC – Spiritual, Moral, Social and Cultural

Although these are separate curriculum areas it is clear that there is a significant overlap within the three areas.

**Strengths identified:**  
Work so far for the development of PSHE includes:

- Draft of a Policy for PSHE
- Building on Welbeck’s already enriched, bespoke work done in PSHE, the curriculum has been divided into four core attributes which represent Welbeck’s vision for its pupils:
  - Global Citizens
  - Healthy Bodies, Healthy Minds
  - Tolerance and Respect
  - Fulfilling Our Potential
- Design of four excellent sheets to illustrate each attribute including vision statements and activities for each area.
- Draft of a PSHE coverage map for 2024-2025
- RC is also updating topics originally covered by DARE eg vaping etc.to ensure areas remain relevant to today’s issues.
- Strong emphasis on online safety continues to be highlighted.

**Areas for development and issues to follow up further:**

- Policy document to be finalised and adopted by Governors.
- Bespoke vision statements for PSHE to be published.
- Coverage map for 2024-2025 to be introduced into teacher's planning.
- Use of Jigsaw programme to fill any gaps.

**Action to be taken following report back to governing body:**

- Ask RC to give a brief report to the PPC on the developments in PSHE and show examples of the attribute sheets/ coverage map etc. that he has produced.
- Governors to adopt new PSHE Policy.

**Evaluation of visit:**

RC has spent much time and thought into developing our new PSHE Policy and Curriculum. The work he has produced is excellent and will ensure that our pupils have the best experiences and opportunities possible to prepare them for their futures and develop into successful adults.
