Objectives of the visit including links to school development plan:

- To ensure new statutory guidelines for RSE are place for Sept 2026
- To review new resource for RSHE – Story Project

Strengths identified:

To ensure new statutory guidelines for RSE are place for Sept 2026:

1. NC has produced an up-to-date RSE Policy that is in line with new guidance.
2. The policy is being put on Governor Hub for all governors to review.
3. The policy will be included on the PPC agenda for June 11th for approval and acceptance.
4. Following this the policy will be published on Welbeck’s website by Sept 2026.
5. The school has a new scheme of work, called ‘Story Project’, to support teachers with their work in RSHE (RSE). I have reviewed this with KW and NC and will ask NC to bring examples to the next PPC meeting for governors to review.
6. Parents will be given the opportunity to review Story Project after half term.
7. School will reiterate parent’s rights to withdraw their child from sex education
8. School continues to actively ensure RSE is accessible for pupils with SEND whenever it is appropriate.
9. The curriculum is inclusive and age-appropriate and aligned with statutory guidance.
10. All staff are well trained through attending courses and CPD sessions and are confident to deliver RSHE.
11. Impact of this work will be monitored through Pupil Voice, children’s behaviour, discussion with parents etc.
12. We are confident that the new scheme of work will support all the new guidelines.

Action to be taken following report back to governing body:

- Review up-dated policy.
- Review Story Project.
- Accept and publish the policy.

Evaluation of visit:

It is clear that NC has worked extremely hard to produce our new RSHE (RSE) Policy ensuring it is in line with all new statutory guidance.

KW has researched and introduced Story Project for use in school to support teachers in their delivery of this subject.

I would like to thank them both on behalf of the governors for their hard work and commitment.
